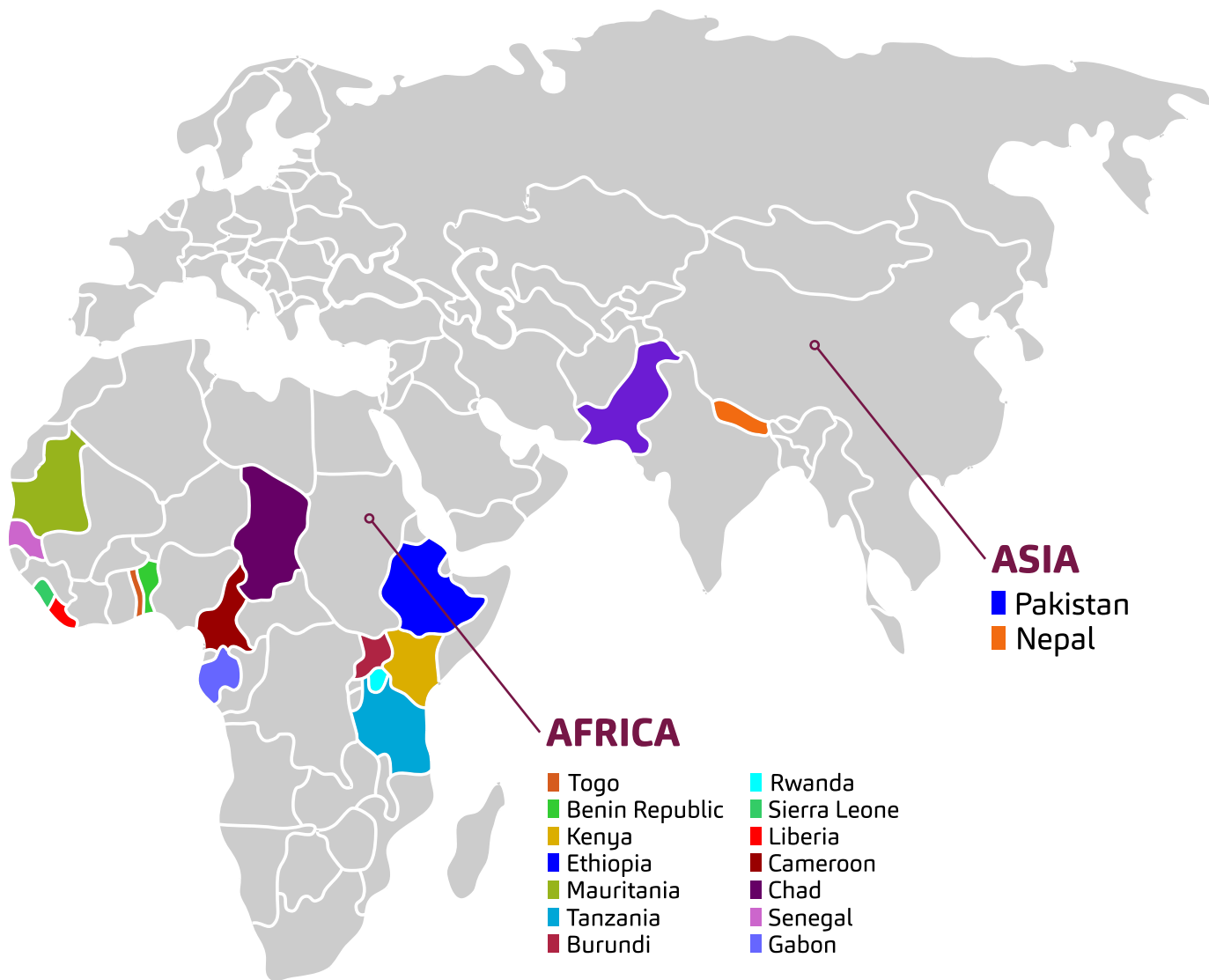

ME Pakistan

For some months coming this year, Mission Enablers Pakistan has been in the works. And to God's glory, our on-ground team of volunteers in Pakistan began full operation in the month of April.

We thank God for the progress experienced by our Pakistan office since its inception.

- A seminar to introduce MEP among young people at district Toba Tek Singh on 1st of May
- Mother's day Celebration on 12th May among brick Kiln women, by God's Grace we distributed a tea cup as mother's day gifts among 10 families
- A visit to the empowerment centres earlier established for displaced women in Jaranwala
- An outreach conducted among the Hindu community in Cholistan desert Bahawalpur south Punjab.
- A seven-day Intercessory prayers conducted for unreached people groups across the world.
- Opening of FIVE (5) skill acquisition centers for economically disadvantaged Christian minority women.

This is with a goal to train and support 100 women in the next 6 months who were victims of persecution from extremists.



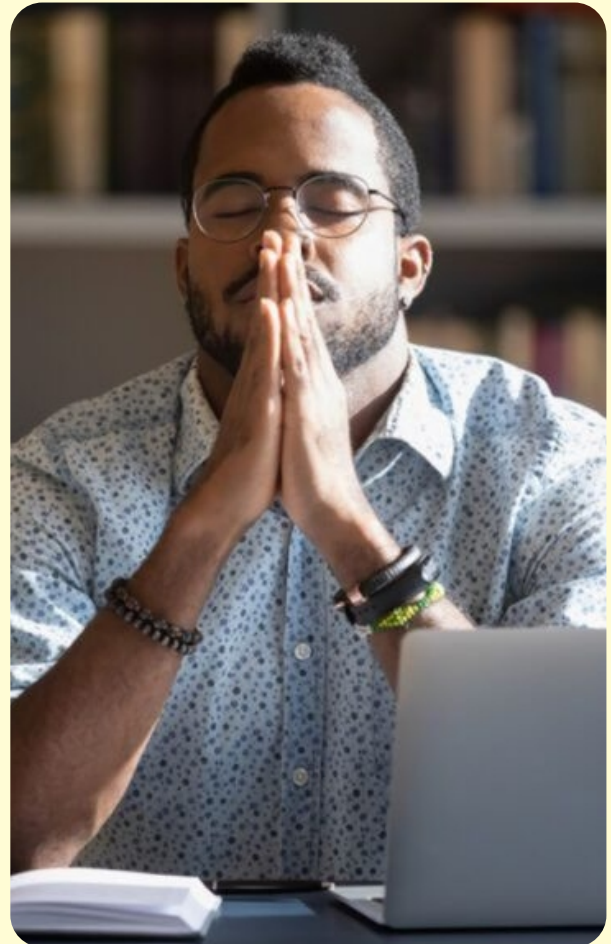
Pray Mandate

In H1 2024, we held various prayer meetings focused on Missions, Missionaries, Unreached People Groups, Persecuted Christians, Kingdom and Financiers

Our dedicated prayer team engaged each of the **52** people groups in prayers daily.



Publicity/Mobilization Mandate

We organized 7 mobilization events with **425 believers** showing interest in missions

Our Student in Missions Conference held in the Olabisi Onabanjo University, Ago Iwoye with **126 students** deciding to commit to missions.

Over **600** University students gather with 14 making a decision for Christ and 126 making an open commitment to get involved in missions.

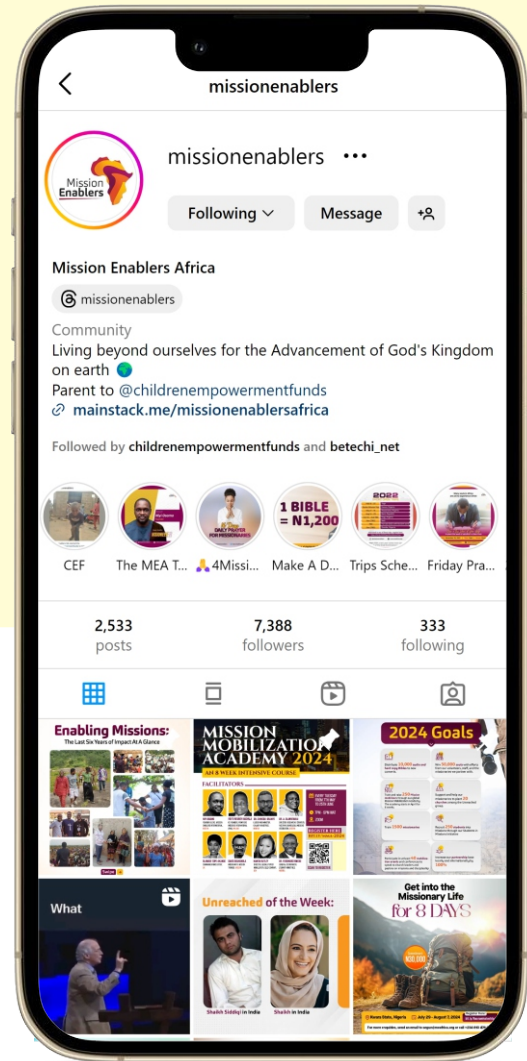
A Global Volunteers Discipleship School was later held in June to further get the students prepared for mission involvements. Their first mission field exposure has been scheduled for August.

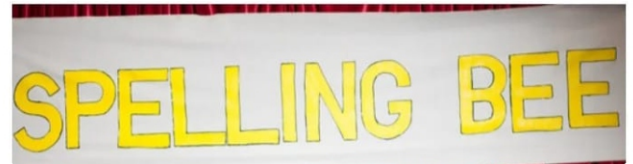
